For example, the sentence If water reaches 100 degrees Celsius, it boils, expresses the fact that water always boils whenever it reaches 100 degrees Celsius. How To Form Zero Conditional Sentences Zero conditional sentences are made up of two parts, lets call them Part A and Part B.Part A is the condition part and is formed by if + present simple. You can also use the word when instead of if without changing the meaning.Part B is the fact part and is formed by using the present simple. Lets look at an example: If you eat a lot (A), you put on weight (B). Zero Conditional Example Sentences Here are 30 zero conditional example sentences. All these examples are zero conditional sentences which express a general truth. The zero conditional form can be extended to other grammar forms, such as imperative sentences (If you need to cross the street, look both ways first.), but for now we will just focus on simple zero conditional sentence examples which express a general truth.
