Life on a stuntman's set isn't particularly fascinating. The days are long, sometimes lasting 14 hours or more. A recovery can often occur in uncomfortable situations à they may spend hours partially submerged in the water or have to take a shot on an icy mountain or a hot desert. The pay for a stuntman can vary greatly depending on his experience and the specific stunt he will perform in a particular movie. Very few people in higher-level stunts make six-figure annual income. The reason for the long hours is that an acrobatics requires planning, preparation, rehearsals and probably several shooting. It takes hours just to place the pyrotechnic charges for a scene with explosions. Most stunts involving cars will require measurements and the installation of ramps and stop barriers. All acrobatics should be tried as close as possible to the actual acrobatics, without any risk factors. For example, a car chase could be executed at low speed or a sword combat practiced with plastic swords. Once the stunt is done, it should be very predictable for all participants. Some stunts may need to be shot multiple times to capture additional camera angles or because something was wrong the first time. However, with many acrobatics, it is not practical to shoot the scene. If the chase culminates in an explosion and a car accident, it becomes prohibitive to destroy more cars to capture the perfect shot. Also, every time you ask a stunt person to repeat a stunt, the risk factor multiplies. These protests led to strikes, including the one of Los Angeles teachers in Grand Park on January 22, 2019, in Los Angeles, California. There, thousands of teachers, parents and students, celebrated an apparent victory when the United Teachers Los Angeles union and the Los Angeles Unified School District reached an agreement that included a cap on class sizes, funding for school nurses, and an increase in educator salaries. This victory was significant, but it is also a testament to the ongoing problems afflicting the education system of the states. If the waves of protesters are not enough to convince the problems related to the remuneration of teachers (and other concerns raised by educators), then perhaps these shocking numbers will do it. Salary.com listed \$ 44,926 as an average initial salary for public educators on 27 August 2021. From the other part of the wage escalator, American elementaries with higher wages. High. Teachers earn \$71,000 a year, while high school teachers earn an average of \$71,000 a year. Meanwhile, in Luxembourg, the highest average salary for primary school teachers is €114,000 (or \$133,316) per year. Looking at things at the state level, New York's teachers are the best, earning an average of \$85,258 (via USA Today) à although New York also requires teachers to achieve a master's degree within the first five years of employment, a warning that can create further barriers for new educators. Other states that compare with New York include California, Massachusetts, Connecticut and Alaska, but many others are at the opposite extreme, including Oklahoma, where "half of all teachers earn less than \$33,630 a year" in 2019. EdTech Magazine asked, "If you were offered a job that paid an average annual salary of \$49,000 and required you to work 12 to 16 hours a day, would you accept it?" It sounds a bit rough, doesn't it? Well, unfortunately, this is the norm for most teachers in the United States. Teachers spent an average of \$745 of their money on teaching materials during the 2019/2020 school year. Teachers also paid about \$252 out of pocket in distance learning materials during the spring of 2020. If you count secondary school work "sports coach, teaching of supplementary courses, extracurricular assistance", the figure rises to 59%. The end result? Public schools should be adequately funded; teachers should receive fair remuneration for everything they do. Despite all this, legislators at Education Week scaled back or even nixed plans to increase teacher pay when the initial pandemic hit. Educators were abruptly pushed into a public health crisis in March 2020. Despite the efforts made by teachers, most schools, particularly public schools, did not have roadmaps for dealing with fully virtual learning scenarios. Indeed, many privately funded universities and schools with seemingly large endowments were also not well equipped.
