Advertising The Arizona Cardinals continued their midseason winning streak, taking their fourth victory in a row in a dominating 31-6 decision over the New York Jets on Sunday at State Farm Stadium. The Cardinals are 6-4 on the season and pushed Aaron Rodgers and the Jets to 3-7. Kyle Murray was almost perfect, hitting 22 of 24 passes for 266 yards and a touchdown. Murray also ran for two scores. This marked the third consecutive home game Arizona allowed no touchdowns. James Conner rushed for 33 yards and a touchdown and caught five passes for 80 yards. Marvin Harrison Jr. pulled in five receptions for 54 yards and a score as the Cardinals outgained the Jets 406 passes to 207. Watch Jets at Cardinals on FUBO (free trial) The Jets took the second-half kickoff and drove down to the Cardinals' 3-yard line, but edge rusher Xavier Thomas forced a strip sack of Aaron Rodgers, Kyzir White recovered the fumble, and Arizona mounted an 88-yard drive for a touchdown. Kyle Murray's second rushing score of the game, this one on a 12-yard scamper to his right, extended the Cardinals' lead to 31-6. They have now scored on all five of their possessions four of them on touchdowns. Murray completed all three of his passes for 41 yards during the drive, which included a 19-yarder to running back Trey Benson and a 12-yarder to tight end Trey McBride. Score: Cardinals 31, Jets 6 (4:31 left in the third quarter) We've now reached the end of the third. Chad Ryland kicked a 37-yard field as time expired in the first half and the Cardinals extended their lead over the Jets by scoring four times on all four of their possessions. Kyle Murray completed all four of his passes for 29 yards during the 10-play, 49-yard drive and is now 17 of 19 for 199 yards with a touchdown, no interceptions and one sack. The Jets' Aaron Rodgers is just 7 of 11 for 40 yards with no touchdowns, no interceptions and one sack. The Cardinals lead in total yards, 239-85, and first downs, 18-8. Arizona has only rushed for 47 yards, but James Conner has caught four passes for 47 yards. The Jets' two receivers have combined for just two receptions for 18 yards. Garrett Wilson has two catches for 18 yards and Davante Adams has no catches on two targets. The Cardinals offense couldn't be more proficient than it has so far against the visiting Jets. Following Kyle Murray's 9-yard fade pass and over-the-shoulder catch by Marvin Harrison Jr. in the corner of the end zone, Arizona has now scored on all three of its possessions of the game, and all three drives have covered 70 yards. Murray completed all seven of his passes during this TD drive for 71 total yards and has now 13 of 15 for 170 yards overall. He completed four passes of 10 or more yards during the five-minute, 53-second drive a 17-yarder to Trey McBride, who hurdled a would-be defender for a third consecutive game, an 11-yarder to tight end Elijah Higgins, and a 13-yarder to McBride. The Cardinals offensive line gave Murray all sorts of time on that pass and Murray was calm and decisive after making his check downs. The TD pass to Harrison, meanwhile, was put in the absolute perfect position for the rookie to make the grab with cornerback D.J. Reed shadowing him closely. There was a brief scare during the drive, however, when Murray was sacked for a 7-yard loss. Linebacker Quincy Williams came in from Murray's blindside and knocked the quarterback off his feet. The hit also resulted in Murray's helmet flying off his head and landing several yards away. Murray, though, escaped, uninjured. Score: Cardinals 21, Jets 6 (4:09 left in the second quarter) The Jets nearly got into the red zone during their second possession, but once again, they were thwarted by a tenacious Cardinals defense. After driving 43 yards on 11 plays, the Jets and Aaron Rodgers faced a third and six situation from the Arizona 27-yard line. Under duress from a confusing D-line setup, Rodgers looked for wide receiver Garrett Wilson, but his pass fell short. New York had to settle once again for another field goal from Spencer Shrader, this one from 45 yards. Score: Cardinals 14, Jets 6 (11:39 left in the second quarter) Two possessions, two 70-yard touchdown drives by the Cardinals. This time, it took nine plays, excluding a pass-interference penalty on the Jets, and Arizona capped the drive on a 1-yard hootleg run by Kyle Murray. With max protection up front at the goal line, Murray faked a handoff, rolled out to his right and saw nothing but daylight as he easily strolled into the end zone. Murray completed two passes during the drive, a 17-yarder to Marvin Harrison Jr. and an 18-yarder to tight end Trey McBride. The Cardinals, by the way, are now a perfect 15 of 15 in goal-to-goal situations tops in the league. Score: Cardinals 14, Jets 3 (2:34 left in the first quarter) End of the first. The Jets scored on their first possession as well, but the Cardinals kept them out of the end zone thanks to a nice pass rush and strong coverage in the secondary on third and six from the Arizona 7-yard line. Aaron Rodgers had five receivers on the play, but he was forced out of the pocket, scrambled to his right, and was forced to throw the ball away to avoid a sack. New York settled for a Spencer Shrader 25-yard field goal following a drive that covered 63 yards on 11 plays. Score: Cardinals 7, Jets 3 (7:48 left in the first quarter) It didn't take long for the Cardinals to find the end zone. Arizona took the opening possession and drove 70 yards on six plays, called by a 1-yard run for a touchdown by James Conner. Quarterback Kyle Murray tried a deep pass to Michael Wilson to open the series that sailed too fair, but then on a play-action call, Murray rolled out to his right and found Marvin Harrison Jr. for an 18-yard gain. After a 7-yard run by Conner, the big play came on a short dump screen from Murray to Conner, who rambled 44 yards, avoiding two tackles. Initially, the play was ruled as a 45-yard touchdown catch and run, but according to referee John Hussey, "The runner's butt check was down" at the 1-foot line just shy of the end zone. Two plays later, Conner ran untouched for the score and Chad Ryland made the extra point. Score: Cardinals 7, Jets 0 (12:58 left in the first quarter) After showing up on the injury report Thursday with an ankle issue and not practicing at all on Friday, Cardinals safety Jalen Thompson was among the list of inactive players for Sunday's game against the Jets. He was listed as questionable. Look for rookie safety Dadrion Taylor-Demerson to get more snaps with the defense because of Thompson's injury. Nickel corner Garrett Williams might also be moved around and offer some help on the back end with veteran Budda Baker. For more insurance, Arizona elevated defensive back Diva'ad Wilson from the practice squad. Also inactive for Arizona is rookie defensive lineman Darius Robinson (calf), linebacker Julian Okwara, tight end Travis Vokolek, offensive lineman Christian Jones and receiver Xavier Weaver. The game is on Sunday, Nov. 10 at 2:25 p.m. MST, 4:25 p.m. ET. The game can be seen on CBS. Streaming options for the game include FUBO, which offers a free trial, and other streaming services that carry CBS. Spere Dedes (play-by-play) and Adam Archuleta (analyst) are scheduled to be the announcers for the Jets at Cardinals Week 10 NFL game. The Cardinals are a 2-point underdog against the Jets in NFL Week 10 odds for the game, courtesy of BetMGM Sportsbook. Arizona is +110 on the moneyline, while New York is -130.
