On the other hand, Pleurocarpi are fast growers who spread carpet-like with more free compositions and more shabby-looking than Acrocarpi. Types of musk1. Musk Tree American (Climacium americanum) SourceIt is a popular moss because it is used to make decorative crafts as well as garlands. It has a dense and ramified bearing with light green color and red-brown stems. It is located along streamlines and native forests of eastern Canada and north of the United States.2. Teeth moss for newborns (Plagiommium cuspidatum) It can grow in almost any type of soil and is used by birds to build their nest. It produces capsule-shaped foliage with red-brown stems at the base. That's why the leaves have dense edges. Prefers colder temperatures and wetlands.3. Brocade Musk (Hypnum imposingns) That's what this is, common in forests that form large spots of densely cyuff rich green color. It has glossy leaves that become orange when it reaches maturity, maturity,buds from rotten trunks, in tree swamps and tree bark. It takes the name because it looks like an embroidered fabric.4. Catherine's Moss (Atrichum undulatum) It is also known as the big star moss because it looks one at an aerial view because of the habit of magnifying its leaves. It has remarkable deep green and rigid textured foliage with white striations. It will thrive in partial sun in full shade and its leaves will turn crispy brown when it is dry.5. Common Hair Moss (Municipality of Poltrichum) is one of the easiest mosses to identify with its long, vertical and spicy foliage. Its leaves are of deep and pale green shades and has reddish brown stems. It loves acidic and very humid soils. When viewed from afar, they look like small stars.6. Common Peat Moss (Central Sphagnum) Common peat moss is used as a soil modification in many gardens. It is a by-product of sphagnum moss and other organic components used mainly for potting mix or for hydroponic growth.7. It is a delicate feather-moss with spicy foliage. It looks very much like ferns decorated with a deep green colour and long burgundy stems. Unlike other mosses that love acid soils, this one prefers alkaline soils. It grows in dense tufts in woods and in very humid locations.8. Dwarf Hair Moss (Pogonatum Aloid) It looks more succulent than moss due to its fleshy foliage that grows like a small rosette. It also has cloudy stems. In general, it looks like miniature aloe vera but with pale red streaks.It thrives in sheltered places and will not tolerate much sun.9. Fern moss (Thuidium delicatulum) is a fast growing moss also known as log moss. They tend to grow on rocks and in other humid locations. It is called as such because they look literally ferns, but with a shabbier look. They have a velvet texture and deep green color. They are often dried and used in crowns. 10. Fire moss (Ceratodon purpureus) is notable for its young branches that sprout on top of the old ones. It forms in mounds and makes a dense moss mat in forests. It has flush-like leaves that are deep green at youth and red as it reaches maturity. It grows in nitrogen-rich soils. As such, you will find it in burnt areas. This is where it takes its name. 11. Sparkling wood Moss (Hylocomium splendens) is sought after for its glossy foliage that glows in the sun. It is a feather and cold-type mousss endemic to Canada, Russia and Scotland. It has long ramifications, red stems and intense and glossy green foliage. It looks like miniature fir and is used in wreaths and other floral displays. 12. Heath Star Moss (Campylopus introflexus) is a fast growing moss native to South America. It sprouts into old wood/doors, fence poles, and into thatched roofs. Has a bright green color in youth almost black when it's old. He also has red stems. In ideal conditions, it is a robust cultivator. As such, it is considered invasive in some areas. 13. Hynpum Musk (Hypnum)It is also known as carpet moss or leaf moss. It is commonly used as a substitute for grass when it comes to lawns. It has ramified, low-growing, silky stems. Its curly leaves come in a range of yellow-green to rich green. It differs from brocade moss due to its lack of midrib.14. Juniper moss (Polytrichum juniperinum) Unlike other types of moss, this moss thrives in dry climates and in the most exposed areas. In fact, it is present on all continents of the world that are commonly found in trails, grasslands and even quarries. It has deep green foliage with an angular feel and small-forming rosettes.15. Humor Moss (Dicranum scoparium) is native to North America and is also known as the broom fork moss. Like the pincushion moss, it grows also on mounds or in zones. It is distinguished by the spear-shaped leaves and the thin, brown stems. It shall not prosper under the full sun, but shall spring up in the trunks, in the rocks, and in the stumps. Pincushion Moss (Leucobryum glaucum) It could tolerate a wide range of soils and thrives in dry climates. It is considered a perennial moss known for its habit of growing in tumuli. Each cushion or mound has branched stems hidden in a pile of grey-green leaves. It has feathered foliage making it look chubby.17. Feathered moss (Pillium crista-castrensis) is also known as the feathered ostrich moss, which is found primarily in Canada and northern Europe. It is also known as a knight's feathered moss because it resembles the feathers of a knight's helmet. It has dense, intense green foliage that produces moss mats in a garden.18. Ribbed swamp moss (Aulacomnium palustre) Also known as marsh moss, it grows dense tufts that form bulky moss mats. Its natural habitat consists of wetlands, which outnumber wild mosses due to their rapid growth rate. It has a nice intense green foliage and brown-orange stems. It is widespread in colder regions such as Canada.19. Rigid beard moss (Didymodon rigidulus) This is commonly sprouted from old pavements, slabs or concrete. It is considered the most common Didymodon species that produces dense, emerald green foliage of carpet-like quality. It will not tolerate much sun as it thrives in sheltered places.20. Sand beauty (Racomitrium canescens) is known to be drought resistant and can thrive in hot temperatures. It thrives well in semi-shaded habitats even in the sands. When it is too dry, the leaves tend to close on the stems and turn light green.After rain or when it is sufficiently humid, it will return to dark green. It grows in dense clusters up to three centimeters tall.21. Shaggy Moss (Rhytidiadelphus triquetrus) This has a blurry appearance with Red-brown stems. It takes its name from its musky, shabby look. It is intense green in youth and will become brown as it matures. It is native to the humid forests of the Pacific Midwest.22. Shiny seductive moss (Entodon seductrix) is a fast growing, fast spreading down moss in a lateral pattern. Its most common common are rotary trunks and old wooden poles. It has a beautiful intense green foliage that will make a good coverage of the soil in the rocky gardens, and yes, it is shiny. He loves the full sun and is native to North America.23. Setoso fork Musk (Dicranella heteromalla) It is a popular acrocarpal moss that grows in acidic soils and tree strains, in moats and in the woods. It has long, narrow, yellow-green leaves curled in the same direction. It has the tendency to grow in a habit agglomerating and will remain curved regardless of where it is cultivated.24. Spoon Leaved Muss (Bryoandersonia illecebra) FonteThis is known for its juicy clear leaves. Their stems are hidden in their dense leaves. When they are older, their pale leaves will become brown. They are found in fertile, rocky and very humid soils. It is considered a rare species in Canada since it is found only in Ontario.25. Spring grassy moss (Rhytidiadelphus squarrosus) It can grow up to 6 inches tall and is tolerant of acidic and very humid/humid soils that are commonly found in meadows and prairies. It stands out for dense leaves and light green color and red stems. It is also spiny and often makes good soil coverage. It is also called the cat's electrified tail.26. Rhytidiadelphus squarrosus (Rhytidiadelphus squarrosus) It is commonly found in the woods near streams, marshes and golf courses. It is known for its ramified stems that produce dense cyuffs of carpet shape. Its stems could reach up to 15 cm in length with acute curves and in an external way.27. Rusty moss / Callicladio Moss (Callicladium haldanianum) FonteCresce in rocky and sandy soils and in humid and semi-shaded places. It has glossy dark green foliage with red spores. It is very attractive for meadows. These are long branches, extending outwards, producing dense quality tufts similar to a carpet.28. Warnsdorff Torba (Sphagnum warnstorffii) is a popular finer for gardens. It is the by-product of the dried sphag musk and is mainly cultivated for this purpose especially in New Zealand and Peru. There are 350 species of sphagnum moss that bloom especially in the northern hemisphere.29. Water screw moss (Syntrichia latifolia) It is low growth at a maximum of just one inch height. It has a shiny look that makes it a decorative moss. It usually has broad leaves, clustered around the burgundy stems. They grow in old trunks, fence poles and shady streets. They have small green flowers.30. Musk White Bearing (Leucobryum Glaucum) This moss is called so for its light green color with whitish tips and the habit to formation of mounds. It produces dense areas up to 4 inches tall and will become blue-green when it receives more rain or when in places with more moisture.
