Jackie Robinson continues to be one of the most important figures not only in baseball history, but in the history of human rights and civil rights. Baseball cards leave behind a Robinson and out of the field. For me, revisiting Robinson the past history of baseball was sometimes desolate. Robinson was a victim of rampant racism that tormented the country on it. In that piece, I take a quick look at Robinson's bottom and success in baseball, while providing collectors with a guide for the most important baseball cards of Robinson. I always love when there is a subject of the statistics to hold the card from a particular player. With Robinson, you have cards of an incredible athlete, while you are also holding some legacy of someone who changed the baseball sport for everything that came after him. Jackie Robinson became the first black player in the big league baseball, Standing in the ebbets field for Brooklyn Dodgers in 1947. Until this point, baseball was a white man's play; believed that most believed that African Americans did not have the Smarts or talents to play baseball of the main league.
