There is a balm in gilead lyrics

Given article text here The region of Gilead in the Old Testament was known for its skilled physicians and a special ointment made from the gum of a tree native to the area. Many believed this balm had miraculous powers, but God told the Israelites that they shouldn't rely on it for spiritual healing or relief from oppression.
