
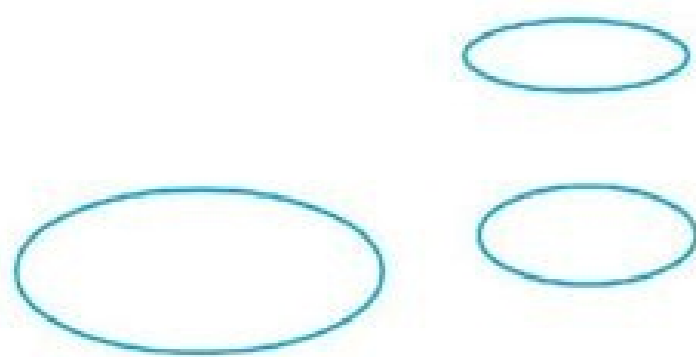

 1. Maximise $Z = 3x + 4y$
 Subject to the constraints: $x + y \leq 4, x \geq 0, y \geq 0$.

Solution:
 The feasible region determined by the constraints, $x + y \leq 4, x \geq 0, y \geq 0$, is given below



O (0, 0), A (4, 0), and B (0, 4) are the corner points of the feasible region. The values of Z at these points are given below:

Corner point	$Z = 3x + 4y$
O (0, 0)	0
A (4, 0)	12
B (0, 4)	16

Hence, the maximum value of Z is 16 at the point B (0, 4).

2. Minimise $Z = -3x + 4y$
 subject to $x + 2y \leq 6, 3x + 2y \leq 12, x \geq 0, y \geq 0$.

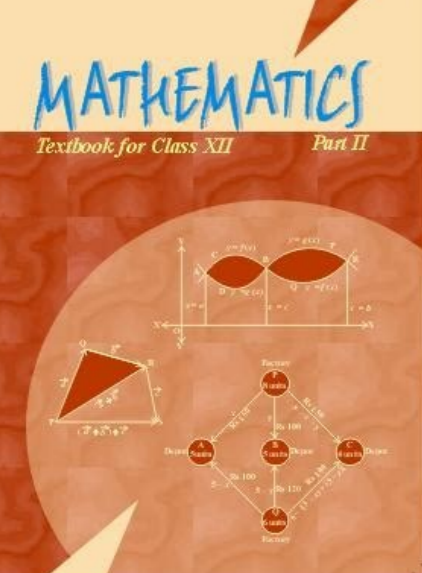
Solution:
 The feasible region determined by the system of constraints, $x + 2y \leq 6, 3x + 2y \leq 12, x \geq 0, y \geq 0$, is given below



O (0, 0), A (4, 0), B (2, 2), and C (0, 3) are the corner points of the feasible region. The values of Z at these points are given below:

Corner point	$Z = -3x + 4y$
O (0, 0)	0
A (4, 0)	-12
B (2, 2)	5
C (0, 3)	12

Hence, the minimum value of Z is -12 at the point A (4, 0).
