Can you get hidden ability starters scarlet and violet

Players can acquire hidden abilities for their Pokémon in Pokémon Scarlet and Violet through two methods: the Ability Patch or catching a Pokémon with a Hidden Ability from a Tera Raid. To obtain Ability Patches, players must complete 6-star or 7-star Tera Raids, which guarantee battling against Level 90s. While rare, these battles offer a chance to drop Ability Patches. To receive Starter Pokémon in Pokémon Scarlet and Violet, download the mobile and Nintendo Switch versions of Pokémon HOME via the Nintendo eShop or Apple Store/Google Play Store. Create a Nintendo Account if needed and link both app versions to the same account to transfer Pokémon. To send Pokémon from Pokémon HOME on Nintendo Switch to Pokémon Scarlet/Violet using your iOS or Android device: 1. Open Pokémon HOME, select the menu button, then Mystery Gifts. 2. Select the Gift Box, choosing the three listed gifts for the Paldean Starters. 3. Close the mobile HOME app and open the Switch HOME app. Before receiving Mystery Gifts, ensure you've sent a Pokémon between HOME and your Scarlet/Violet copy since May 24th, 2023, at 01:00 UTC. This will add Scorbunny to your team. Hidden abilities cannot be found in wild Pokémon; instead, use an Ability Patch or finish Tera Raids for a chance to obtain them. There is no way to get hidden ability starters directly through breeding, but using a Ditto can help you potentially get offspring with the desired hidden ability. The starter Pokémon in Scarlet and Violet don't have hidden abilities like previous generations; they still have Overgrow, Blaze, or Torrent abilities. You can encounter all three starters throughout your journey. To obtain an Ability Patch, participate in 6-Star Tera Raids. Check your Pokémon's Summary to see if it has a hidden ability, but unlocked ones won't show up yet. Not every Pokémon is created equal when it comes to their hidden abilities; some are indeed very powerful. In competitive gameplay, unique strategies include using Multiscale for Dragonite, Libero for Cinderace, and Toxic Boost for Zangoose, among others. In Pokemon Scarlet and Violet, it's not possible to catch all three starters (Sprigatito, Fuecoco, and Quaxly) without trading with other players. The secret starter Pokémon are Sprigatito, Fuecoco, and Quaxly. Starters in Scarlet and Violet are shiny-locked, meaning they can't be found as shiny Pokémon. Sprigatito can be bred in the Pokémon Nursery, allowing you to obtain it with its hidden ability. Getting a female Sprigatito requires luck and multiple soft-resets at the beginning of the game. To get Charizard in Pokemon Scarlet, connect to the internet and enter the password "DARKTERA0006" in the Mystery Gift section. Hidden abilities can provide a strategic advantage in competitive gameplay, but they're not always better than regular abilities. Obtaining a Pokémon with a secret ability is rare and requires luck, with some cases having a 1 in 256 chance of encountering one. You cannot soft-reset for a hidden ability starter or get the Galarian starters (Grookey, Scorbunny, and Sobble) in Scarlet and Violet. Torchic is also not available in these games. Some Pokémon are exclusive to either Scarlet or Violet, with missing Pokémon including Patrat, Watchog, Pansage, Simisage, Pansear, Simisear, Panpour, Simipour, and Furfrou in Scarlet, and Koraidon, ancient Paradox Pokémon, and certain others in Violet. You can obtain a Hidden Ability on your Pokémon by participating in high-end raids or capturing them from 6- and 7-Star Tera Raid Battles. Ability Patches are items that allow you to swap your Pokémon's Ability with one of its Hidden Abilities. To get an Ability Patch, complete a 6- or 7-Star Tera Raid Battle, open your bag, and navigate to the item. Then, apply the patch to the Pokémon of your choice. This method is best used for special Pokémon like shinies or legends. Alternatively, you can catch Pokémon from these raids and have a higher chance of them having their Hidden Ability. However, if you're trying to breed more Pokémon with a specific Hidden Ability, you need to have one already. Another method is to breed two Pokémon with the same species but different genders, resulting in an egg that will hatch into a Pokémon with the desired Hidden Ability. Players who link Pokémon Scarlet and Violet with Pokémon HOME will receive three starter Pokémon: Sprigatito, Fuecoco, and Quaxly, along with their Hidden Abilities Protean, Unaware, and Moxie respectively. These rewards are available in the mobile version of Pokémon HOME. To transfer these Pokémon to Pokémon Scarlet and Violet, players can link their game with Pokémon HOME after its compatibility update on May 29. The update is expected to last for 30 hours, during which time players can start transferring their Pokémon. This update offers a great opportunity for players to complete their Pokédex and get the preferred Starter Builds for competitive Ranked Battle. Among the starters, Protean Meowscarada stands out as an excellent choice due to its ability to change types without Terastallizing. Fuecoco's Evolution Line consists of Crocalor and Skeledirge, both with unique abilities that make them valuable additions to any team. Additionally, Quaxly's Evolution Line includes Quaxwell and Quaquaval, which boast impressive stats and neutral coverage with their dual STAB moves. The Paldean Starters can be received as a free gift in Pokémon HOME, making it an attractive option for players who want to enhance their teams without spending money on the app. Once the update is live, players can start transferring their Pokémon from HOME to Scarlet and Violet. Select Gift Box to receive Paldean Starters. If not seen, try closing the app and reopening it to reset data. Open the Nintendo Switch version of Pokémon HOME to see your new Starters reflected, and transfer them to Pokémon Scarlet/Violet.
